



Seasonal Parking Ban Ends 5 p.m. Thursday, November 26

The seasonal parking ban that began on Tuesday, November 24 at 11 p.m. will end at 5 p.m. on Thursday, November 26. Crews will be working up until 5 p.m. and enforcement will continue on seasonal parking ban routes until that time. After 5 p.m., residents who live on signed collector/bus routes will be allowed to park curbside again.

Due to expected warm-up of temperatures, neighbourhood blading will not take place at this time. The City will be monitoring neighbourhood streets to ensure our roads are safe.
