

Enhanced service, schedule changes on ETS routes

There will be minor changes to some Edmonton Transit System (ETS) bus routes starting Sunday, December 6 as ETS makes seasonal adjustments to improve service reliability and connections. In addition, eight new ETS bus routes equipped with Smart Bus technology will begin providing enhanced service to customers:

- Route 35 (Century Park Leger Riverbend South Campus/Fort Edmonton)
- Route 37 (Century Park Leger)
 Route 39 (Century Park Rutherford))

- Route 39 (Century Park Rutinetrori))
 Route 47 (Century Park Allard)
 Route 70 (Mil Woods Transit Centre Lakewood 82 Avenue Downtown)
 Route 125 (Jasper Place Westmount Kingsway/Royal Alexandra Hospital Downtown)
 Route 126 (West Edmonton Mall Northwest Industrial Westmount)
 Route 130 (University NAIT Northgate)
