

Help create Edmonton's newest waterfront promenade

The City of Edmonton has partnered with River Valley Alliance on five initiatives that will improve access in the river valley. Citizens are invited to provide feedback to help inform the vision for one of the projects, a waterfront promenade called Touch the Water.

Located on the north bank of the North Saskatchewan River near the new Walterdale Bridge, the promenade will create places for Edmontonians to gather and enjoy the river valley. Feedback can be provided through an online survey from December 8 to 22, 2015.

The survey will help inform two conceptual designs for the Touch the Water promenade. The designs will be made available for public feedback in 2016.

The City of Edmonton was awarded \$72.9 million funding from the River Valley Alliance for five projects designed to improve access in the river valley (projects were funded by the provincial and federal governments in 2013). The Touch the Water Promenade budget is \$10.4 million.
