

## Freezeway skating trail opens in Victoria Park

Winter is a wonderland in Victoria Park, where the new Victoria Park Freezeway will open at 4 p.m. on Tuesday, December 22. The public is invited to skate through the woods along this romantically-lit path, nestled in the heart of the River Valley, and warm up afterwards at the new Victoria Pavilion. The Freezeway leads off the Victoria Skating Oval and features the work of lighting designer Dylan Toymaker.

The Freezeway was inspired by landscape architect Matt Gibbs, who, as part of a master's thesis in 2013, proposed a downtown skating path for Edmonton. Gibbs has been part of the development of the Victoria Park Freezeway, which was a shared project of WinterCity Edmonton, Make Something Edmonton, the Edmonton Speed Skating Association and the City of Edmonton.
