



## City seeks feedback on fares charged by the vehicle for hire industry

The City is looking for input on how taxis and private transportation companies, such as Uber, could charge fares under the proposed new [Vehicle for Hire Bylaw \(see item 7.5\)](#) to help ensure a fair system for both industry and the public. **Feedback is being accepted through an [online survey](#)**, which will remain open until Monday, January 11, 2016.

Results of the survey, along with input provided by the taxi industry and Uber, will be shared in a report to City Council when the proposed bylaw goes for second reading on Tuesday, January 26, 2016. The new regulations, which would allow private transportation providers like Uber to operate legally in Edmonton, will not come into effect until after the bylaw receives three readings.
