



Let's envision a future for 109 Street!

The City of Edmonton's Envision 109 project is launching with a public open house asking residents how they envision the future of 109 Street, between 61 Avenue and the High Level Bridge.

Date: Wednesday, January 27, 2016

Time: 4:30 - 8 p.m. (presentations at 5 p.m. and 6:30 p.m.)

Location: St Basil's Cultural Centre, 10819 71 Avenue NW

109 Street acts as both a main street, with distinct character areas, and a prominent commuter route, linking downtown and south central Edmonton. There is potential to enhance the appearance and usability of this important corridor. In recognition of this, the City is engaging in a streetscape concept design project, Envision 109, to revitalize and improve this busy public space. The project will propose streetscape improvements without major infrastructure changes in the short term, as well as consider major road redesign in the future.

Edmontonians are encouraged to be part of the discussion by sharing their ideas and future vision for 109 Street to help the City produce a responsive concept plan.
