



Walterdale Bridge update and photo opportunity

Another major milestone in the construction of the new Walterdale Bridge is about to take place with the first of two arch lifts scheduled for Tuesday, January 19. Join project engineers for a photo opportunity and brief status update.

Date: Tuesday, January 19, 2016

Time: 10 a.m.

Location: Northeast corner of Kinsmen Sports Centre parking lot ([view map](#))

Members of the media will have the opportunity to take photographs of the bridge and the work being done to prepare for the arch lift. There will be a safety overview before the event.

NOTE:

- Full personal protective equipment (PPE) will be required for the site tour. This includes steel-toed boots, hard hat, safety vest and protective eyewear. Media representatives are asked to please provide their own PPE. Due to site conditions, heels or open-toed shoes of any kind are not allowed.
- A **maximum of two** representatives from each media outlet will be allowed on site.
- This is an active construction site. Visitors are required to follow safety guidelines and stay within the tour area at all times.
