



Hawrelak Lake opens for skating

Hawrelak Lake is now open for public skating. The ice surface at this popular River Valley location will be open from 11 a.m. to 10 p.m. daily, with the warming pavilion open from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m.

City staff members are working to improve the ice condition, which is currently rough and may be difficult for beginners. Young and inexperienced skaters are encouraged to wear helmets on all City of Edmonton ice surfaces.

The alternate ice surface in the southeast section of William Hawrelak Park is now available for shinny players. Free outdoor skating is also available at the City of Edmonton's Castle Downs, Jackie Parker Park and City Hall ice surfaces, as well as the Victoria Park Oval and Freezeway.
