



Community meeting on traffic management measures in Pleasantview

Edmontonians are invited to attend a community meeting presenting feedback from residents about the trial traffic management measures installed in Pleasantview in July 2015. To better accommodate schedules, the City is hosting two identical sessions.

Location: Ramada Edmonton South, Coral Room, 5359 Calgary Trail

City staff will share feedback collected from the last three workshops, the project email and hotline, and a January 2016 telephone survey of a representative sample of Pleasantview residents. The City will then share go forward plans for the Pleasantview Community Traffic Management Plan (CTMP).

Edmonton's City Council endorsed a new CTMP study for Pleasantview in 2013, following the community's successful expression of interest effort where more than 25 per cent of households indicated support for completing a study. The City, in consultation with the Pleasantview community, began a traffic management planning process in early 2014, with trial traffic management measures installed in Pleasantview starting on July 20, 2015.
