



Showcase your infill development ideas

Registration is now open for Edmonton's first ever [infill design competition](#). This competition is intended to showcase design innovation and best practices that improve the quality of infill development in the City.

This is an open competition. Architects, designers, planners, students and anyone with creative ideas about infill are invited to submit proposals. The competition should demonstrate that infill can enhance, rather than detract from the character of our established neighbourhoods.

Registration closes May 31, 2016 and deadline for submissions is August 31, 2016.

Up to \$15,000 in prizes may be awarded, with a maximum cash prize of \$2,000 for any single award. All winners will be honoured at an awards gala on Thursday, October 20, 2016. Winners will be featured in future City of Edmonton print and/or web materials.

Infill is a form of home building that preserves the livability of existing neighbourhoods and has been occurring in Edmonton since 1920. The City of Edmonton is excited to promote and celebrate innovation, character sensitive design, and advance the design ethic for infill development in Edmonton.
