



Snow storage facilities closed for public use

The City of Edmonton has closed its snow storage facilities to public use. The facilities are made available for contractors and other members of the public for snow dumping during the winter months, but there has not been a significant snowfall in recent weeks.

The snow storage facilities are located at:

- 184 Street 107 Avenue (Poundmaker)
- West Side 50 Street and South of Highway 37 (25104 - 50 Street (Horsehills))
- 156 Street Ellerslie Road
- 17 Street North Whitemud (approximately 52 Avenue)

The snow storage facilities will remain closed until a significant snowfall warrants re-opening.
