



## Share your views for a renewed Jasper Avenue

The City is continuing public consultation for the Imagine Jasper Avenue project with a drop-in open house. The section of Jasper Avenue from 109 Street to 124 Street is slated for full reconstruction beginning in 2018.

At the open house, Edmontonians will help confirm the vision that is taking shape for Jasper Avenue as a Main Street and vibrant streetscape that meets the needs of the community, commuters, businesses and visitors. City staff will share the themes from the feedback received in the first stage of consultation. Through hands-on activities and discussion, participants will learn about the factors that will influence future design options.

This is a family-friendly event with fun activities for children.

### Main Streets

Jasper Avenue is Edmonton's historical Main Street. The section from 109 Street to 124 Street will be designed and reconstructed following the City's guidelines for Main Streets, which states: "Main Streets are not only transportation links, they are streets that will be designed to act as strong community places and often have a tie to business and community revitalization."
