

City shares 50 year forecast of three urban growth areas

With Edmonton's population projected to be 2.1 million in 2064, City Administration continues its long range planning for that growth. Chief City Planner, Peter Ohm will provide a brief overview of the Integrated Infrastructure Management Plan report to be presented at Executive Committee March 22.

The report outlines a 50 year projection of costs and revenues for three priority growth areas (Decoteau, Horse Hills and Riverview). Ohm will also talk about an innovative new tool being developed by City Administration that will significantly increase capacity to forecast growth and the revenue/costs of that growth. The Growth Modelling Framework can help Council to assess and prioritize future revenue investment for a sustainable Edmonton.
