



Check out Queen Elizabeth Park designs

Representatives from the City of Edmonton will be sharing conceptual plans highlighting exciting new changes and additions to upper Queen Elizabeth Park.

Date: Saturday, April 2, 2016
Time: 8 a.m. - 3 p.m.
Location: Old Strathcona Farmer's Market, 10310 83 Avenue

The primary feature development will be the outdoor Indigenous Art Park, a first in Canada, that will feature art pieces completed by Canadian Indigenous artists. The park will also include improved shared use paths, a new parking lot, picnic area, and a commemorative wall acknowledging the former site of the old Queen Elizabeth outdoor pool.

The updates are a part of the Queen Elizabeth Park master plan approved by City Council in 2013. This is the second phase of renovations. The first phase, the construction of an accessible, asphalt walking trail from the lookout at 106th Street and Saskatchewan Drive to Queen Elizabeth Park Road, is currently underway with expected completion by the end of June 2016.
