Featured projects:

- **The Garden of Truth Project** will turn a vacant lot into a park to honour the area's aboriginal heritage.
- **The 106 Avenue Streetscape Project** will improve infrastructure on 106 Avenue between 97 Street and 101 Street beginning this summer.
- **The Norwood Boulevard Corridor Study** aims to improve transportation and enhance land use and urban design policies.
- **Church Street Special Character Area Zoning** calls for new land use regulations to preserve and enhance the character of Church Street.
- **Community Economic Development of McCauley** will provide small businesses the opportunity to develop sustainable access to local amenities.
- **The Chinatown Economic Development Plan** aims to revitalize Chinatown's economy.
