



Terwillegar Park Footbridge construction update and photo opportunity

April 14, 2016

A major milestone in the construction of the new Terwillegar Park Footbridge is taking place with the installation of deck panels on the bridge's suspension cables. The deck panels will form the walking surface of the footbridge. Edmonton will be one of only two Canadian cities with this type of footbridge and it will be the second longest stressed ribbon footbridge in the world.

Members of the media will have the opportunity to take photographs of the bridge and the work being done. There will be a safety overview before the event.

NOTES:

- Full personal protective equipment (PPE) will be required for the site tour. This includes steel-toed boots, gloves, hard hat, safety vest and protective eyewear. Media representatives are asked to please provide their own PPE.
- A **maximum of two** representatives from each media outlet will be allowed on site.
- This is an active construction site. Visitors are required to follow safety guidelines and stay within the tour area at all times.
