

Major traffic delays and pedestrian detour on 101 Street downtown

April 18, 2016

A series of utility and roadway projects for Rogers Place and ICE District will reduce traffic to one lane in each direction on 101 Street, from 103 Avenue to 105 Avenue, starting Monday, April 18. This will cause major traffic delays in the area until early September, 2016.

During this time, certain turns will be affected:

- From April 18 to April 22 there will be no left turn from 101 Street southbound to 103A Avenue eastbound (except transit)
- From April 23 to May 8 there will be no right turn permitted from 101 Street southbound to 104 Avenue westbound
- From April 23 to May 8 there will be no left turn permitted from 103A Avenue westbound to 101 Street southbound (except transit)

Drivers are asked to detour using 97 Street or 109 Street to avoid major delays.

Pedestrian access on the west sidewalk will also be closed starting Monday, April 25, continuing until early September, 2016. Pedestrians are asked to use the east sidewalk on 101 Street instead.

The City of Edmonton thanks people for their patience during what will be a busy construction season as the development of many downtown projects continues.
