



## Spring schedule changes start Sunday for ETS buses

### *Departure time changes and construction detours for 13 routes*

April 21, 2016

Edmonton Transit System (ETS) customers are encouraged to double-check their schedules for new departure times and potential route detours starting Sunday, April 24. Seasonal service reductions take effect for post-secondary routes.

Griesbach Road: Routes 164 and 169 are detouring due to construction on Griesbach Road. Some riders may need to leave extra time to get to available bus stops. Buses operate along 153 Ave. and 97 St. in both directions.

127 St. from 118 Avenue: - Yellowhead Trail: Departure and travel times have been adjusted for routes 12, 115, 128, 150 and school specials. Routes are detouring to the perimeters of the Prince Charles and Sherbrooke communities. Some riders may need to leave extra time to walk to available bus stops.

A free temporary community shuttle service (Route 398) is available within Prince Charles and Sherbrooke, departing every 20 minutes. Detour and shuttle maps are available from [takeETS.com/projects](http://takeETS.com/projects).

Whitemud Dr. and 53 Avenue: Departure and travel times have been adjusted for routes 23, 30, 32, 33, 36 and 38. While the 53 Avenue over Whitemud Drive Overpass rehabilitation project is in progress, bus stops 4567, 4158, 4279, 4020, and 4191 are closed. Temporary bus stops are in place outside of the construction zone.

Customers are advised to allow for extra travel time and/or catch an earlier bus when possible, especially when traveling during peak/rush hours.
