

Construction on 127 Street set to begin

April 22, 2016

Starting on Sunday, May 1, 127 Street reconstruction from 118 Avenue to Yellowhead Trail will close both southbound lanes and will reduce northbound traffic to one lane for the next three months.

The closures are necessary to provide safe space for construction staff to work on the narrow roadway. Detouring through 121 Street and St. Albert Trail is recommended.

Additionally, all bus stops on 127 Street will be closed during construction which is anticipated to be completed by October 2016. Bus routes 12, 115, 128 and 150 will be detoured from 127 Street and Sherbrooke Avenue. Afree temporary shuttle through Sherbrooke and Prince Charles will connect to the changed routes. New schedules are available on takeETS.com.

The City of Edmonton greatly appreciates the patience of citizens as we work on this essential link in city's transportation road network.
