The City of Edmonton is proud to introduce the brand new Council Committee on Energy Transition. The committee, made up of 15 citizens, will serve a two-year term and help implement the plan outlined in Edmonton's Community Energy Transition Strategy, approved by Council in April 2015.



The mandate of the committee is to encourage and promote the strategy, liaise with the City Manager and City Council on implementation of the strategy, and help develop performance measures. The committee will meet every two months and will provide a wide and strategic perspective on issues relating to energy transition in Edmonton.
