Edmontonians are asked to donate non-perishable food items and toiletries. Most-needed items include: canned meat or tuna, pasta and pasta sauce, macaroni and cheese, canned or dry soup, rice, canned dinners or stews, deodorant, feminine hygiene supplies, toothbrushes, toothpaste, travel-sized shampoo and conditioner, and toilet paper.
