

ETS upgrades West Edmonton Mall Transit Centre

Some bus stops move temporarily to 87 Avenue

May 13, 2016

Construction begins Monday, May 16 on improvements to the West Edmonton Mall Transit Centre. Improvements include:

- Replacing the transit centre building
- Enhancing safety with more security cameras, better sight lines within the transit centre, better outdoor lighting, and redesigned sidewalks
- Increasing comfort with a larger indoor heated waiting area and added seating
- Installing public art, upgrading building design and completing platform improvements

All bus stops at the centre island are temporarily closed. Buses are moving to other stops in the transit centre or to temporary stops on 87 Avenue between 172 - 175 Street WB. Please check the transit centre map to see if your bus stop has changed. Please see [map](#).

Westbound traffic on 87 Avenue from 170 Street to 178 Street will be reduced from three lanes to two lanes to allow for buses to stop. Stay left to detour.

Construction is expected to last until early 2017. West Edmonton Mall transit centre is one of three facilities, including Abbottsfield and Belvedere seeing improvements this year. The City of Edmonton thanks transit users and motorists for their patience while we complete this project.
