During a two hour tour of the facilities you will learn how:

- Garbage is used to create compost at one of North America's largest composting facilities
- Recyclables are sorted and prepared for market
- Decomposing garbage inside a landfill is used to create electricity
- E-waste such as computers and TVs are recycled
- Non-recyclable and non-compostable waste will be turned into methanol and late ethanol at the waste-to-biofuels facility.
