

## Metro Line service changes: June 26 and July 10

## Summer bus schedules begin this Sunday

June 23, 2016

On June 26 and July 10, buses will replace the Metro Line from the start of service until noon from Churchill to NAIT stations. Replacement buses will run every 15 minutes. Bus stop locations are available <u>here</u>. Temporary service changes are the best way for Edmonton Transit System (ETS) to perform planned work as safely and quickly as possible.

Regular buses and Capital Line trains will run as scheduled. University station will also undergo maintenance this Sunday, with trains operating in both directions on the northbound track (Track 1) until 10 a.m.

Permanent service changes and summer service reductions are also in effect starting this Sunday. Changes include major adjustments on Routes 5, 15, 44, 69, 96, 125 and 127. Starting on June 27, ETS will limit the number of operating school specials, including post-secondary routes.

ETS adjusts bus routes five times a year to respond to customer feedback and optimize service delivery. Some changes are seasonal and some are more significant in order to accommodate ridership patterns, new communities or construction.
