The City operates four outdoor pools: [Fred Broadstock](#) (15720-105 Avenue), [Mill Creek](#) (9555 84 Avenue), [Oliver](#) (10315 119 Street) and [Queen Elizabeth](#) (9100 Walterdale Hill).

Borden Park Outdoor Pool remains closed for redevelopment.

Season passes are available from \$49 for unlimited use of all outdoor pools. Annual recreation centre memberships are also accepted at outdoor pools.
