

102 Avenue bridge to open this summer

The 102 Avenue over Groat Road bridge replacement project is expected to open to traffic in early August instead of late September as anticipated.

"Our priority has always been to open up the bridge as soon as it was safe to do so," said Adam Laughlin, Deputy City Manager of Integrated Infrastructure Services. "An early start to this year's construction season has allowed us to announce an improved opening date. We're all looking forward to reopening this important corridor."

Once open, there will be two traffic lanes in each direction with pedestrian access on one side while the finishing work takes place through the summer and fall. Finishing work includes completing sidewalks, installing railings and replacing the concrete median on Groat Road.

Single-lane closures of the bridge will be required during off-peak hours to allow the work to be completed. There will also be closures of Groat Road to complete the remaining activities.

Transit service will also be restored along 102 Avenue.

The City of Edmonton thanks the local businesses on 102 Avenue and 124 Street, residents, motorists and trail users for their patience.
