



LRT service adjustments Wednesday evening

Crews working near University at track level

July 12, 2016

From 8 p.m. until end of service on Wednesday, July 13, Metro Line trains will run between NAIT and Bay Enterprise Square station only, instead of going to Century Park or Health Sciences. Riders need to transfer to a Capital Line train at Churchill, Central, or Bay Enterprise Square station to continue south.

Capital Line trains will single track and provide north and south bound service on Track 2 at University and Health Sciences stations. All other stations will have regular service on both tracks.

Crews are performing a planned switch repair near University Station. Adjusting LRT service is the safest and quickest way to perform the work. Regular service resumes with start of service on Thursday, July 14 on the Capital and Metro Line.
