

Get ready to celebrate at the K-Days Parade

July 20, 2016

Experience the excitement and pageantry of the 2016 K-Days Parade. On Friday, July 22, 2016 the streets of Downtown Edmonton will be teeming with more than 100 entries to delight parade-watchers including beautiful floats, giant balloons, amazing performers, loveable mascots, horses, antique cars



This year's parade will begin at 10 a.m. at 100 Street and 103A Avenue. Pre-parade activities will begin along the parade route beginning at 9 a.m.

Parade Day travel delays, parking and road restrictions

Edmontonians who live and work in the Downtown area are reminded about road closures and parking restrictions on parade day

- Main Assembly Area closed 6 a.m. until 2 p.m. The assembly area, located between Jasper Avenue and 103A Avenue, from 95 Street to 97 Street, will be closed at 6 a.m. Access to off-street parking facilities in the assembly area will be available until 8:30 a.m. from the intersection of 102A Avenue and 95 Street only.
- The west 97 Street service road from 102A Avenue to 103A Avenue is a pre-staging area for the parade and will be closed from Thursday, July 21 at 7 p.m. until Friday, July 22 at 2 p.m.
- Parade Route closed from 8:30 a.m. until 1 p.m. The parade will start at 100 Street and 103A
 Avenue, travelling southbound on 100 Street to 102A Avenue/103 Avenue. It will then head west to
 107 Street, where it will turn south, heading to 102 Avenue. At 102 Avenue, it will travel east to 100 Street and then head north, back to the assembly area
- Access to the Edmonton Law Courts will be affected by the parade route. Please take this into consideration and adjust your travel time accordingly to ensure that you will arrive on time for your appointment or court hearing.

ETS routes in the Downtown area will detour for the parade starting early morning until the parade clears. Please check detour times for specific routes, as they may vary. Regular transit fares apply.

Getting to the Parade: Use LRT or Routes 1, 2, 3, 5, 7, 8, 9, 15, 16, 52, 70, 81, 100, 111, 112, 120, 134, 140, 151, 308 or 309. Extra service going to the parade is on Routes 1, 2, 7, 8, 9, 16 and 140. Leaving the parade, Routes 1, 2, 3, 5, 7, 8, 9, 16, 81, 100, 112, 140 and 151 have extra service.

Skip Downtown road closures and parking restrictions on parade day by taking the bus or LRT. Use an ETS Day Pass to go to the parade and K-Days. Just \$9.25 and allows unlimited travel on ETS on a single day by one adult and up to four children ages 12 and under travelling with that adult
