



Downtown road closure: 104 Ave from 101-105 Street

August 19, 2016

104 Avenue between 101 and 105 Street will be totally closed, starting 7 p.m. Tuesday, August 23, and will reopen at 6 a.m. on Monday, August 29. This is to do roadway work related to Rogers Place.

Travellers going east/west can detour using 100, 102, 107, or Jasper Avenue. Travellers going north/south can detour using 97, 101 or 107 Street.

During this phase, the Rogers Place construction crews need full access to 104 Avenue as crews need to take out most of the two northern lanes, rebuild the base and put in new asphalt. A small portion of the lanes will be milled and paved.

Closing this road was timed during this short window of time between major festivals and events downtown to minimize the impact of this road closure. A total closure also shortens the amount of time the roadway is impacted by construction.

Emergency access to the area will be maintained.

We thank Edmontonians for their patience as we continue to revitalize our Downtown.
