

## Rogers Place public open house tickets released

Tickets are available through Ticketmaster or <u>Rogers Place com</u> for the Rogers Place public open house, which will be taking place from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Saturday, September 10, 2016. The open house comes before any concerts or hockey games, and gives people an opportunity to see the public areas of Edmonton's newest arena.

Tickets are free and the public will be required to book a scheduled arrival/entrance slot between 8 a.m. and 3 p.m.. This will allow organizers to space out crowds and give the tens of thousands of interested people the opportunity to attend.

There is a limit of four tickets per email address. Tickets are general admission, so if your group is larger than four people, two members can reserve tickets for the same time slot and arrive together.

You can be one of the first people to tour Rogers Place on September 10 by visiting the Rogers Place social media channels and sharing what you're most excited to see at the open house using the hashtag #RogersPlace.

Event organizers encourage guests to plan ahead as there is important information to note. For example, the main entrance to Rogers Place is located at 103 Avenue and 103 Street, as guests will access the building through a portal that will take them safely through the construction surrounding Rogers Place. Among the highlights of the tour will be seeing the Ford Hall artwork by world-renowned Indigenous artist Alex Janvier, the NHL's largest true high-definition scoreboard, and the bright, wide concourses offering an impressive array of food and beverage options.

Guests will receive a souvenir booklet that will provide maps for their self-guided tour of Rogers Place, which will take between 60 to 90 minutes.
