



Buses replace Capital Line LRT north of Coliseum service this weekend

September 1, 2016

Starting Saturday, September 3 until start of service on Tuesday, September 6, Capital Line LRT service will be suspended north of Coliseum station. This will be the final of three weekend shutdowns related to planned upgrades. The work was split into phases over three weekends, when travel demand is lightest, in order to minimize disruptions to LRT users.

During this time, bus shuttles between Coliseum and Clareview stations will run approximately every 7-8 minutes. Bus stop signs are marked "LRT Replacement Service" and exact locations are listed on the ETS website. Regular buses will operate at transit centres as scheduled, including Late Night Owl Service (Route 512). Metro Line trains will also run as scheduled.

LRT service is scheduled to resume with start of service on Tuesday, September 6.

Once done, the work will improve the LRT's ride quality and lifespan.
