



## Survey asks whether vehicles for hire need markings

The City of Edmonton is looking for input on whether private transportation vehicles should have markings that identify them. There has been feedback suggesting that the more prominent the markings are on the vehicle, the more opportunity there is for hailing the vehicle from the street.

Discussion on the new Vehicle for Hire Bylaw with the industry and the public is continuing. The next [public survey](#) starts on September 9, 2016 and closes September 29, 2016 at 11:59 p.m.

These questions will also be distributed to the Insight Community and will be used as part of a mixed topic survey. The Insight Community is where Edmontonians can share their thoughts with the City of Edmonton, along with other people in the community. Anyone 15 years of age and older who lives in the city or owns property in Edmonton is welcome to become a member.

Results of the public survey, along with input provided by the industry, will be shared in a report to Executive Committee on Tuesday, October 18, 2016.
