

Vote on the best infill design for Edmonton

The City of Edmonton invites all Edmontonians to take part in the City's first Infill Design Competition.

Eighteen of the more than 80 infill design entries received from across North America have been shortlisted in the "People's Choice" Award category of the competition. [Voting online](#) is now open and **closes on October 3, 2016**. The entry with the most votes wins.



Edmonton is undergoing a rejuvenation. As one of the only municipalities in Alberta that continues to see population growth, there is a growing demand for infill in Edmonton's core and mature neighbourhoods. Last year, 13 per cent of new housing was built in our mature and core neighbourhoods.

The City of Edmonton is excited to showcase design innovation and best practices that improve the quality of infill development in the City. The Infill Design Competition is just one of many initiatives the City is working on to help encourage more and better infill in Edmonton. The competition was inspired by Action 8 of Edmonton's Infill Roadmap, the City's two-year work plan for advancing infill in Edmonton. The "People's Choice" competition category was created to invite everyone to learn about the breadth of possibilities for infill design in Edmonton and to continue the evolving infill conversation.

Competition winners will be announced at the Edmonton Infill Design Competition Gala on October 20, 2016.
