The City of Edmonton proudly supports Edmonton's Food Bank. Donations of nonperishable food items will be gratefully accepted at all participating facilities.

Edmontonians are strongly encouraged to make use of the Edmonton Transit System (ETS) to get to their destination. ETS will be operating the Route 594 shuttle service from the West Edmonton Mall to the Edmonton Valley Zoo approximately every 15 minutes between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. **Regular fares** apply for all ETS service.

Due to high traffic, parking will be limited at all facilities. There is no designated facility parking for the Downtown Community Arena. Buena Vista Road N.W. is under construction and will cause delays for those travelling to the Edmonton Valley Zoo.

Capacities vary at each facility and admission may be controlled for safety and security purposes.

Please note that Free Admission Day is only for the participating facilities listed. It does not apply to all facilities or other City of Edmonton services
