Edmontonians are invited to "Nature to 91 Street," an all-day event including tree, shrub and wildflower planting, music, snacks, a seedling giveaway and more.

Location: The east side of 91 Street, north of 34 Avenue
Admission: Free

Parking is limited. Attendees are advised to walk, bike or use public transportation.

"Nature to 91 Street" is being held to celebrate another successful year in the city's tree planting program Root for Trees. It's an opportunity for schools, community members and families to learn about Edmonton's native trees and fruit-bearing shrubs, how planting wildflowers helps our native pollinators, and to get tips on how to live greener.

"Nature to 91 Street" is the final Root for Trees planting event for 2016. Volunteers with the program plant approximately 16,000 trees and shrubs each year. Volunteers and sponsors of the program will be acknowledged during the event.
