



127 Street reopens to traffic

127 Street between 118 Avenue and Yellowhead Trail has reopened to traffic in both directions. The project, which began in May, was completed on schedule.

The project included removal and reconstruction of the roadway, drainage catch basins, sidewalks, and streetlights, as well as work on the south side of the Yellowhead intersection. Final landscaping work will be done in spring 2017.

The City of Edmonton appreciates drivers' patience and the cooperation of Sherbrooke and Prince Charles residents as we completed this essential transportation link.
