

Terwillegar aquatic centre reopens following regular maintenance

The aquatic centre at Terwillegar Community Recreation Centre will reopen to the public on Tuesday, November 1, 2016, following the completion of regular maintenance.

Regular maintenance ensures our facilities are safe, secure and clean for Edmontonians to fully enjoy. Several safety improvements were also made at the aquatic centre. All in-pool lights were replaced with high efficiency LED lights to increase underwater visibility for patrons and lifeguards. Also, imperial depth markings were added to the pool side to show water depth in both metric and imperial, and removal of decorative features to enhance access to pools.

As part of the City of Edmonton's commitment to providing sustainable, quality facilities, all recreation centres undergo regular maintenance, which requires a shutdown every two to three years. We thank the community for its patience during the shutdown.
