The City of Edmonton is leading development of the EETP to to capitalize on servicing northern Alberta's resource extraction industry while also growing the petrochemical and manufacturing sectors. The EETP is intended to bring together industries such as petrochemical processing, manufacturing, transportation, and research and development in northeast Edmonton as part of [Alberta's Industrial Heartland](#).

The City is preparing an amendment to the Area Structure Plan (ASP) to improve the investment readiness of the EETP. The proposed changes to the ASP include a new medium industrial zone, a revised arterial road network and a streamlined plan for land use.

City of Edmonton staff will share proposed changes and be available to answer questions and receive feedback.

Anyone interested in the development of this area is welcome to attend the open house. Those who may be especially interested include landowners within or near the EETP, community organizations within or near the EETP, land development and real estate professionals.
