



City works to reduce impact of overflow from 30 Ave storm sewer to Whitemud Creek

The City of Edmonton is working to reduce the impact of recurring overflow from the 30 Avenue storm sewer crossing to Whitemud Creek during periods of significant rainfall. Citizens are invited to learn more about the options the City is considering at a public information session.

Residents and trail users will have the opportunity to ask questions and share their feedback.

About the Project:

The current project is to design and construct overflow channel improvement work for permanent mitigation measures to address the overflow issues and prevent future erosion damage due to overflow from the 30 Avenue storm sewer crossing to Whitemud Creek. The creek crossing acts as a bottleneck to the drainage system, which has resulted in overflows during heavy rainfall.
