"On behalf of the City of Edmonton, we offer our deepest sympathies to the family and friends of the young pedestrian involved in a fatal collision last night. This is a tragic event for everyone. Our thoughts and prayers go out to them.

The safety of passengers, pedestrians and other drivers is the top priority for Edmonton Transit System and City Operations. We are deeply concerned about this incident. The City of Edmonton will continue to work with Edmonton Police Service on this investigation. Internally, we will promptly launch a full operational review and take action to minimize the potential for any future tragic event."
