

Open House: proposed new Gorman Neighbourhood Plan

Residents are invited to an open house to discuss an application to prepare a new Neighbourhood Structure Plan for the Gorman Neighbourhood. The proposed Neighbourhood Plan provides information on general locations and types of development for future land uses as well as details on the location of major roadways, transit and utilities in the neighbourhood.

There will also be a presentation on the land use planning process at 7 p.m.

An amendment to the Pilot Sound Area Structure Plan is included in this proposal. If approved, the plans will allow for the zoning, subdivision and future development of the area. Gorman is bounded on the west by the Brintnell and Cy Becker neighbourhoods, north and east by Anthony Henday Drive, and south by the Fraser, Kirkness and Ebbers neighbourhoods.
