

City of Edmonton flood mitigation program to build dry pond in Tawa

The City of Edmonton is hosting a public information session on the construction plans for a dry pond in the Tawa neighbourhood. This is a flood mitigation project aimed to reduce risks of flooding during periods of significant rainfall events.

Citizens will have the opportunity to ask questions and share their feedback.

Tawa Dry Pond is a flood mitigation project involving the construction of a dry pond in Sister Mary Ann Casey Park and sewer improvements in the Tawa, Hillview and Weinlos neighbourhoods. This project is part of the City's Expanded Flood Mitigation program that was developed as a result of the July 2012 storm events.
