Metro line trains run every 30 minutes this Sunday

February 3, 2017

Edmonton Transit System (ETS) crews will perform required track work at Churchill station on Sunday, February 5 from 8:30 p.m. to midnight (end of service). During this time, LRT service will be adjusted to complete the work as quickly and safely as possible.

Transit riders boarding Capital Line and Metro Line trains at Churchill station will need to use Track 1 for both directions. Metro Line trains will run every 30 minutes between Churchill and NAIT stations instead of the regular 15 minute frequency. Capital Line trains will run every 15 minutes as scheduled. Regular LRT service will resume at the start of service (approximately 5:10 a.m.) on February 6.
