Mid-winter bus schedule changes begin February 12

Better connection times and new stop locations

To improve customer service, Edmonton Transit System (ETS) will introduce minor schedule changes for 14 routes starting Sunday, February 12.

Bus connections at keytiming points will change for routes 15, 17, 47, 85, 117 and 161. Bus stops for routes 6, 40, 73 and 301 will move within Southgate Transit Centre. School routes 874 and 876 from W.P. Wagner High School will now end at Milwoods Transit Centre.

Route 562 is a new regional route that will provide service from Spruce Grove and Acheson to West Edmonton Mall Transit Centre and South Campus Transit Centre. Route 331 will upgrade to a full-size bus and operate every 15 minutes during peak service.

Riders are encouraged to plan ahead by double-checking bus schedules or tracking their ETS bus by phone or computer. Now all ETS buses can be tracked in <u>real time</u>.

ETS adjusts bus routes five times a year. Some changes are seasonal or more significant in order to accommodate customer feedback, ridership patterns, new communities or construction.
