Transit Information

Enjoy unlimited all-day travel and transfers for one adult and up to four children (ages 12 and under) with an ETS Day Pass for only \$9.50.

On Family Day, buses and LRT operate on Saturday schedules, with modified schedules on some routes:

- Routes 25, 26, 77, 164, 168, 195, 198, 331, 333 and 381 operate on weekday schedules.
- Route 315 operates with reduced weekday schedules.
- Route 137 operates during peak times only, for every 30 minutes.

Regular ETS fares apply.

Whether it's your first time using the bus or you're not sure about special holiday service, don't get stuck waiting at the bus stop. Use <u>real-time tools</u> for your desktop or mobile device to see exactly when the next bus will arrive.
