LRT trains run every 20 minutes this Sunday

February 24, 2017

Edmonton Transit System (ETS) riders taking the LRT this Sunday, February 26, will see a slight adjustment to schedules as crews continue track-level work at Central LRT station.

From 5 a.m. to 6 p.m, Capital Line and Metro trains will run every 20 minutes instead of the normal frequency of every 15 minutes. This adjustment will allow crews to complete work as quickly and safely as possible.

Transit riders boarding Capital Line trains will need to use Track 2 for both directions at Churchill, Central, Bay/Enterprise Square and Corona stations. Metro Line trains will run between Churchill and NAIT stations only, meaning passengers travelling further south of Churchill will need to transfer to a Capital Line train method "Corona Path". marked "Century Park."

Customers are encouraged to plan ahead. LRT arrival signs will be temporarily shut off, but travel details will continue to be available through the Transit Trip Planner at text-ake-ETS.com.
