This two-day introductory seminar is the first phase of a three-part Crime-Free Multihousing certification process. It will feature presentations on topics such as crime prevention through environmental design (CPTED), drug and gang awareness, and landlord/tenant rights and responsibilities.

The Crime-Free Multihousing program launched in Edmonton 15 years ago, making it the first city in Alberta to participate in the accredited North American safety program. The program is coordinated in partnership by the Edmonton Police Service and the City of Edmonton Landlord and Tenant Advisory Board.
