LRT trains run every 20 minutes on Sunday

March 24, 2017

On Sunday, March 26 from 5 a.m. to 6 p.m., Edmonton Transit System (ETS) will adjust Capital and Metro Line trains to run every 20 minutes instead of the normal 15 minute frequency, while track-level work continues at Central LRT Station.

ETS riders will need to use Track 2 to board Capital Line trains in both directions at Churchill, Central, BayEnterprise Square and Corona LRT stations. This allows crews to perform work quickly and safely.

Metro Line trains will run between Churchill and NAIT stations only. Passengers travelling further south of Churchill will need to transfer to a Capital Line train marked "Century Park."

During this time LRT arrival signs will not be in service. Customers are encouraged to plan ahead through the Transit Trip Planner at <u>takeETS.com</u>.
