This is the first phase in the NERC Functional Planning Study, a joint partnership between the City of Edmonton, the City of Fort Saskatchewan, Strathcona County, Sturgeon County and Alberta Transportation.

The proposed bridge would provide an alternate route over the river, connecting Highways 21 and 15 (Manning Drive), improving access to Highway 63 leading north. Construction of the proposed bridge is not expected for another 25 to 35 years.
