Mill Creek daylighting survey now open

The City of Edmonton has been exploring opportunities to re-establish the natural, surface flow and connectivity of the downstream reach of MII Creek- a process known as daylighting. After extensive study and public consultation, three conceptual designs for daylighting were developed.

The three conceptual designs were developed on the basis of technical considerations, environmental planning goals, and feedback received from stakeholders, partners, and the general public. They represent three potential focuses for daylighting: ecological, trail connectivity and destination park. Depending on input received, the final design may resemble one of the conceptual designs presented, or a combination of features and elements from two or more of the conceptual designs.
